1. General Presentation

Making digital technology a driver of entrepreneurship: such is the promise of the Ministry of Posts and Telecommunications. Transforming ideas into viable businesses. Such is the ambition of the Innovators Bootcamp, organized as part of the Digital Innovation Week (SIN). Since its first edition, this intensive training camp has prepared project holders for the final pitch, equipping them with skills in business models and business plans. But for its 5th edition, the Bootcamp marks a break: no more classic format, it's time for total immersion with the **Digital Sprint Experiential Bootcamp**.



This year, the 15 preselected projects (ideas and prototypes) will not just learn: they will live a real business creation experience. At the heart of the program: the business model and financial forecasts, which are the foundations of any viable business. But also other aspects that are too often overlooked: operational management, team management, and a crucial issue that many young entrepreneurs do not know about – the tax incentives and exemptions put in place by the Cameroonian government, through the Directorate General of Taxation. This is what makes it the the **Digital Sprint Experiential Bootcamp**.

This bootcamp is much more than just training. It is a duty to inform, a bridge between public policies and local actors, and an accelerator that turns idea holders into digital entrepreneurs ready to conquer the market. **The Digital Sprint Experiential Bootcamp**.

Goals to achieve:

1. ***Strengthen the economic viability of projects***, by mastering the development of the business model and financial forecasts.
2. ***Demystify the legal and tax environment*** by informing entrepreneurs about the incentives and exemptions made available to them by the Cameroonian State.
3. ***Prepare for operational management*** by covering the fundamentals of business management, team management and stakeholder relations.
4. ***Build a culture of real-world entrepreneurship*** through immersive role-playing, so that each participant leaves with a clear vision of the steps involved in setting up and developing their business.

1. 4. Program structure

To achieve these goals, the Scientific Committee has prepared a tailor-made program for the candidates, built around a variety of complementary formats:

- **Talkshow:** an interactive exchange with experts and industry personalities, giving participants practical insights on key topics (tax incentives, exemptions, legal framework, etc.).
- **Seminar / Introductory course:** theoretical input on the fundamentals of digital entrepreneurship, technical team management and financial forecasting.
- **Immersive role-playing:** a full-scale simulation where participants are faced with realistic business creation scenarios (negotiation, legal compliance, adapting to unexpected events).
- **Participatory workshop on the business model:** small-group work on the participants' real projects, to build or consolidate their business model canvas.
- **Collaboration workshop:** group work sessions that foster collective intelligence and peer-to-peer experience sharing.
- **Participatory workshop on communication techniques (Pitch):** a hands-on workshop to master the art of the impactful pitch, from speech structure to stress management and body language.

The Digital Sprint Experiential Bootcamp program is structured around three intensive days, designed to support the 15 preselected project holders in maturing their digital solutions. Each module is led by experts and industry professionals, ensuring quality support and personalized feedback.

- **Day 1:** participants lay the foundations of their digital business. After an introduction to digital entrepreneurship and an overview of the economic ecosystem, they build their business model and discover the tax incentives and exemptions made available to them by the Cameroonian State.
- **Day 2:** participants strengthen the financial viability of their project through a workshop on financial forecasting. They also benefit from an inspiring talk with former laureates, a hands-on workshop on managing a digital development team, and training in communication techniques to master the art of pitching.
- **Day 3:** participants present all their work to the trainers and their peers, practice their pitch in front of a restricted jury, and finalize their presentation files and communication materials for the final phase of the competition.
